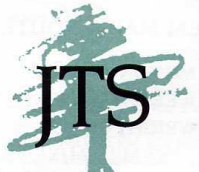

## Program: History of Janesville Transit System

Dave Mumma presented a program on the history of the Janesville Transit System.

What has now evolved into the City of Janesville bus system began in the late 1800s under private ownership. Use of public transportation declined severely after World War II due to prosperity and the use of private transportation. In danger of losing the availability of public transportation, the City of Janesville purchased the system in 1952 with authorization via a City Referendum. By the 1970s, Janesville was again in danger of losing the system due to the poor condition of an aging fleet of buses. Rescue came in the form of a Federal Grant in 1978 to upgrade the fleet.



Preventive maintenance and planned replacements have kept the program in tact since. Dave pointed to the Beloit-Janesville Express route as a success story which is supported by a combination of public and private funding
