Lisa spoke for Community Action Inc., a non-profit organization geared to offer help for folks at or near the poverty line in wages. They offer guidance, contacts, and in some cases financial help. They are 100% local and independent in each community they have an office in. She gave an excellent example of a woman, single mom who earned what would appear to be an OK wage, was at 140% of the poverty level, and with necessary expenses including rent, food, car, and child care was left with \$6 extra each month. This did not include clothing, school supplies, etc. Community Action can help such a person manage expenses and improve their situations.
