Our Program:

Meals on Wheels was on the docket today presented by Mary Bealer.

The program has been in effect since 1970 when Mrs. Hicky started out delivering 7



days a week to 9 subscribers. Back then the meal cost was 1.25. Today the program delivers 135 meals a day 7 days a week for 3.25 per meal, the meals are delivered by volunteers from 28 churches and local service clubs like ours.

The program charges the recipients for the meals and runs fundraisers to cover the costs for those who cannot pay. The Janesville program receives no funding from any outside source. The meals are prepared and delivered from Mercy Clinic West. They are always in need of volunteers.
