Ace of Hearts Drawing:

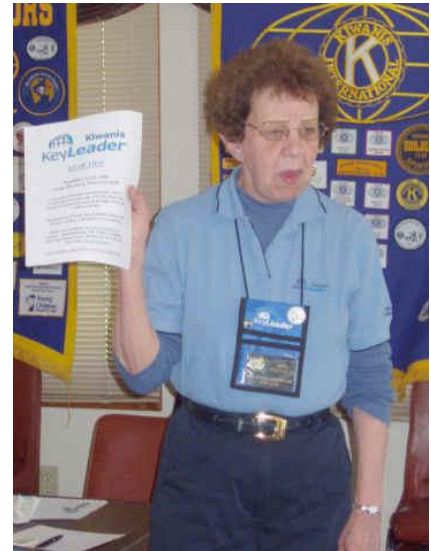
