Gina Cooper, 2005-2006 Alice in Dairyland. Alice in Dairyland started in approximately 1948 to celebrate Wisconsin's 100th anniversary of statehood. The name comes from a combination of two popular events of that time: Release of a new movie- *Alice in Wonderland* and placing the moniker on license plates in Wisconsin-*America's Dairyland*.

Alice is an employee of the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture. Qualifications for the position include: 21 years old, college or tech college graduate, 2 years experience in public relations field, and be female.

The main focus of Alice's endeavors is the promotion of Wisconsin's \$15 billion agricultural and \$35 billion dairy industries.

They include: There are 13,000 farms in Wisconsin. This accounts for 1/4 to 1/3 of the land area of the state. Ninety-five percent of these farms are family owned. Only 15-20 farms raise 1,000 or more cows for dairy. The average herd is 85 COWS.

Myths debunked: *Happy Cows live in California!* Whenever folks hear this, the audience goes out and buys Wisconsin cheese. Actually, Wisconsin leads in direct marketed milk and biofuel development categories. Wisconsin is second in total milk production, but first in fine cheese making and export.
