Tom Stehura “ Chinese Writing “ Tom had a respectable list of credentials most of which the editor missed. I did get that he learned Chinese in the Air Force and later received a degree from University of Wisconsin in Madison in Chinese. He also added that he has probably forgotten more Chinese than most people will ever know. Tom showed the different types of Chinese characters. Chinese has 777 different sounds but they can be used to mean many different things. There is a Chinese Braille for the blind. There are only a few different strokes that are used in Chinese letters but each character may use from 1 to as many as 64 strokes. Dragon is the most complicated which uses the 64 strokes for 1 character. All characters are the same size however no matter how many strokes are used. Tom's program was very interesting but the Chinese sounds to be a difficult language to master.
