We had Dave and Mary Utzig in today from Tannenbaum Acres choose and cut Christmas tree farm out on Hwy 11 West. They were very informative on the Christmas tree farming business that they have been involved in for over 50 years.

Here are a few facts: For every tree harvested they plant 3 seedlings. There are 21,000 Christmas tree growers in the US, Wisconsin ranks 3rd. It can take up to 15 years to grow a tree of average retail sale height (6-7 feet) or as little as 4 years, but the average is 7 years.

The top selling Christmas Trees are: Balsam Fir, Douglas Fir, Fraser Fir, Noble Fir, Scotch Pine, Virginia Pine and White Pine.
