- Dr. Jim Damrow announced that the Fest shirts have arrived ... please pick them up at next meeting or contact Dr. Jim.

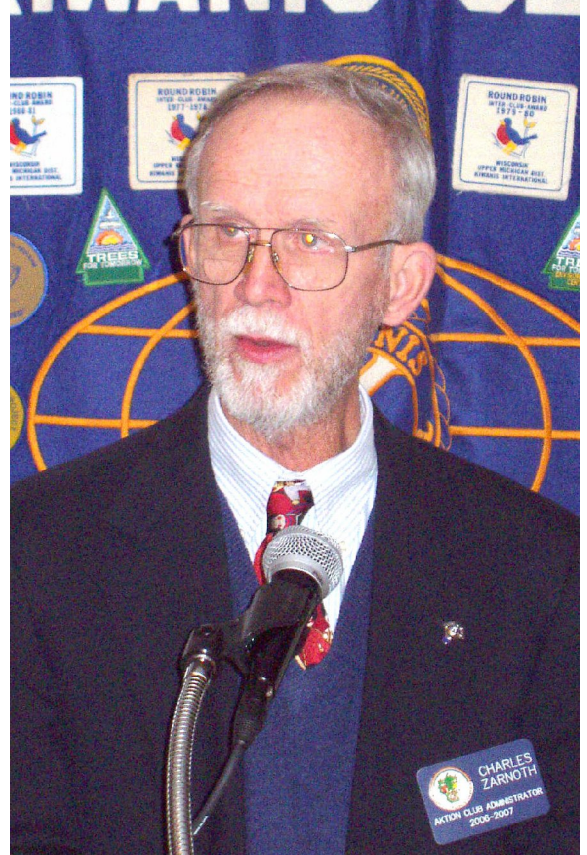
Ace of Hearts Drawing:

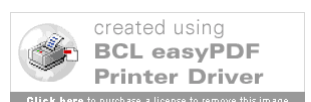
