Shelley Sturdevant, Coordinator with the County Victim & Witness Assistance Program, which is part of the Rock County D.A.'s office.

Mrs. Sturdevant reported on the mission to help crime victims and on the services provided to them. All counties in Wisconsin except one have an Assistance Program.

Her department meets with crime victims to inform them of their rights, inform them of Court dates, provide community referral information for services by counselors, Child Protective Services, ECHO, etc.

She serves as the interface between the victim and the D.A.'s Office who is prosecuting the defendant. Sometimes the victim is a young child. In this situation the child's parents are also victims of the crime, because they must understand the charges to be made by the prosecutor and usually must speak and make decisions in their child's behalf.
