The idea came from a program in 1995 where low income youth were given the opportunity to not only fly an airplane but be paid to participate. Because they were paid they needed to follow strict guidelines to remain in the program.

This was a one time course after which the participants returned to their past to forget the lessons they had learned. The Wisconsin Aviation Academy was started to keep these low income youth involved. The Academy guarantees to instill three basic skills. They are Planning, Discipline, and Communication skills.

Some of the many programs offered include Flying Falcons which offers free flights to hundreds of students age 7-17 each year. There are also many field trips the students can participate in.

Tom has committed much time, energy and personal finances to this program and I am sure he would welcome any donations made to the Wisconsin Aviation Academy.
