The Program:

Jennifer Ramsdail – CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocates) Coordinator spoke about the important work her volunteers do in helping the at-risk youth of Rock County.



Volunteers trained to work individually with children to assist the courts and social workers by supporting and spending time with at-risk kids. Volunteers act as the eyes/ears of the judge and file monthly reports on child's progress to the judge. Rock County has over 800 kids placed out of their homes per year and over 200 CHIPS (Child in need of protection or service) Petitions filed per year. No County funding provided, so rely on donations and fund raising. Currently have over 40 trained volunteers.
