Traci Nolan from Rock County Habitat for Humanity was in the "house" today. She brought us up to speed on the various house builds they have in progress, as you know Habitat for Humanity is an international organization providing responsible candidates with affordable housing. The candidates are responsible for contributing 250 hours of "sweat equity" before being allowed to purchase the house from Habitat using an interest free loan provided by Habitat. The candidates are required to take classes on budgeting and money management as that is often time the major contributor to their inability to acquire a home. The Rock County chapter has been in existence since 1990 and has built 38 homes, none of which have ever had to be foreclosed upon.
