The holidays and cold weather

have a tendency to bring out the space heaters which account for 75% of deaths and 30% of fires during the winter season. Be sure to keep the space heater in the room where you are and turn it off when you leave. Remember to follow all manufactures instructions when it comes to plugging in your space heater as circuit overloads are common during this time of year.

When decorating your Christmas tree remember to check the lights you use and be sure they are in good repair. Any bare wire should be taped to avoid contact with the tree. If you have a natural tree be sure to keep it watered. A natural tree will drink a gallon of water every 1-2 days. If it dries out it can burn like gasoline once started.

Check smoke and carbon monoxide detectors to ensure proper operation, locate near or inside your bedroom.
