Police Officer Shaun Mahaffey was in the house with his canine partner Hardy. Hardy is the 1st Police Dog for the

Janesville Police Department and comes to us from Germany; yes he is a German Sheppard. He weighs in at 82 pounds. He has been in Janesville since October and has already been put to use over 70 times, mostly in searching vehicles for drugs.

He lives with Officer Mahaffey and only takes commands from him. He has a very gentle disposition until called into action at which time you do not want to be on the receiving end. The Police Department is expecting to get funding for another canine unit soon.

K-9 team dogs are used to ensure public and officer safety. Police dogs are able to expertly track and are a helpful resource when looking for criminals, evidence, missing persons or suspects. They are great protectors and may be utilized when searching buildings or open spaces. Police dogs are also effective at controlling crowds.

The K-9 team will be a critical tool in Janesville's drug enforcement strategy. The dog will be used to search for and detect narcotics in buildings, containers, vehicles and areas where narcotics can be concealed.

Short notice availability is the most powerful benefit of having a K-9 team. Not only will the dog be available for emergencies such as bank robberies or reports of missing children, but the team can also assist with routine day-to-day operations.
