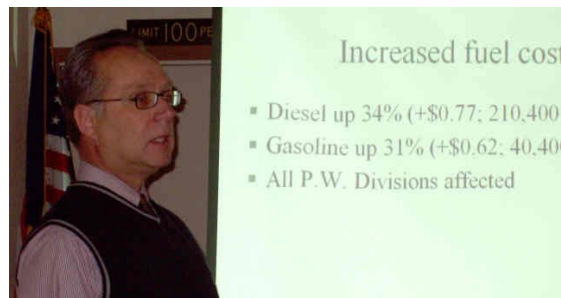
-Ed Pulliam got a letter from Will Parks saying his Pancake Day in the Quad Cities was fun, but not as good as Janesville's
