Anne Walli was with us today to discuss her involvement with SARP: Sexual Assault Recovery Program.



SARP provides services to survivors and families who have been a victim of all forms of sexual violence, including recent/past sexual assault, incest and sexual harassment. They do this by providing a 24 hour crisis hotline, support groups, community education, attendance at the hospital for victim support and legal/medical advocacy.

SARP assisted 136 people last year and 192 the year before, the oldest victim was 86 the youngest 6 weeks old.

Sexual violence is any act verbal/physical which breaks a person's trust and or safety and is sexual in nature. Victims/survivors of sexual assaults are forced, coerced and or manipulated to participate in unwanted sexual activity.
