Bob Johnson, from the Blackhawk Golden K Kiwanis Club, spoke about hiking the Appalachian Trail from Georgia to Maine. The hike took him 2 months to complete and covered 500 miles!

Bob talked about the difficulties of carrying everything you need in the wilderness on your back including sleeping bag, cooking gear, clothing, food and water. Most important hiking items were his shoes which kept him from slipping on rocks in dangerous areas, walking poles to keep his balance on steep inclines, and gloves that saved his hands when he was tumbling down a mountain grabbing rocks to stop his decent.



Bob promoted local hiking trails and encouraged us to use the Ice Age Trail right here in Janesville.

Bob talked about the 30 pounds he lost and has kept off after his trip (which he brought up AFTER we had finished our huge meal).

Finally, Bob talked about the wildlife they experienced, including bears and timber rattlers! Those interested in taking on such a hike should call him as he has loads of useful information of items necessary for such a trip.
