Marie Bilek was with us today to discuss Meals on Wheels. It was Easter Sunday in April of 1970 that the first meals went out in Janesville at a cost of \$1.25. The 1st meal consisted of Prime Rib, Asparagus, Potatoes, Gravy and Dessert.

The folks that deliver today will tell you that meals like that are a thing of the past, the meals today are great and healthy but not Prime Rib and are delivered at a cost of \$3.25.

Lois Hickey was the individual that got the program set up in Janesville back in the day.

No outside funding is used to support the operation, no subsidies are received which is unheard of in an operation of this kind. Most other if not all programs like this receive funds from United Way or some other organization.

Thanks to volunteers and Mercy Hospital the program delivered almost 37,000 meals last year.
