Our Program:

The City charges a low dumping fee, compared to fees charged in states surrounding Wisconsin.

Another concern is the cleaning chemicals and pesticides used in our public schools. Julie feels there is a danger to some students, and she is advocating the formation of a Green School Committee that would study and inform public school officials of dangers to some students.
