Students Report on Badger Boys & Girls State American Red Cross in Rock County

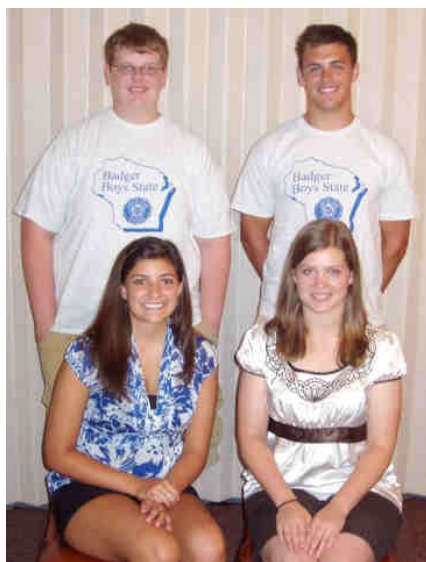
Guests: Guests for today's meeting: Interclub visits by representatives of the Greater Beloit and Milton Kiwanis Clubs.

We also heard from David Diestler and Catrina Schoen, representatives of our local American Red Cross Chapter. The Red Cross provides a number of services to our community, nationally, and internationally: disaster relief, health and safety training, health and safety products, education, training, blood collection, and emergency communications for families with members in the military anywhere in the world.

In June, the chapter was actively involved with helping people who had to leave their homes due to flooding along the Rock River. They set up shelters at St. John's Lutheran Church, Aldridge Middle School in Beloit, and a facility in Ft. Atkinson, so victims had a place to sleep and receive meals.

Blood collection has been a major work of Red Cross chapters for years. Locally, they helped collect over 7,000 units of blood in 2007 from donors in Rock, Green, and southern Jefferson counties. Only 5% of citizens donate, more are needed.
