Today's Program:

Lt. Russ Steeber, Rock County Sheriff's Dept. spoke of the Workender Program. This program started in June 2008, and it is a means for low risk law offenders to work off fines by working on weekend community projects rather than staying at the County Jail.



The offenders have not been arrested for serious crimes, and they live at home during the other 5 days of a week. The person can continue working at a regular job, being a student, and having a normal life during the week, and then helping with a community service project on weekends. There are 30 participants now, male and female.

The benefits to Rock County are a reduced population at the jail, community service that assists non-profit groups such as us, emergency work, i.e. sand bagging last month to reduce flooding, and a lower cost of operating the Jail. Lt. Steeber hopes the Workender Program will grow, and that more projects can be performed.
