Adam Elmer from the Rock County Health Department was with us today discussing Radon Gas in Rock County.



Radon is an odorless, colorless, tasteless, radioactive gas that derives from the natural decay of uranium in soil and rocks. It seeps into

buildings through cracks, gaps and other openings in contact with soil. It is the 2<sup>nd</sup> leading cause of lung cancer after smoking, although the Radon rate of lung cancer is dwarfed by the smoking rate.

As this area of Wisconsin has a higher than average rate of occurrence for Radon it is recommended that we test our homes.
