Program:

This was like a step into the past –
with Tom at our meeting - speaking –
Tom is a past President of our club.
Rumor has it that he may be willing to
reactivate his membership and he can
be spearhead our Parks relationships.

The Program – Tom reviewed how
much we as Kiwanians have helped
the city in the development and
maintenance of our Parks projects.



In 1986 the Club was began the
development of Kiwanis Pond. The old
Atlas Pit. We have since invested
over \$40,000 in improvements. We
have continued to do clean up days
and planting days and now we need to
do repairs to the Fishing Pier which
was built in 1992-1993. It seems water
levels have changed and the pier is
now under water. (Literally)

In 1992 our club undertook the
Kiwanis Park project, on Holiday Dr &
Pontiac. We have since invested over
\$46,000 in improvements. We
continue to do flower planting and
some maintenance at the Park.

Our Club also started the Kiwanis
Trail. The Trail was proposed in 1974
and built in 1979. We have invested
over \$10,000 on the Trail and spend
time in keeping it clean and beautiful.
