Chief Moore reports on Janesville Police Dept.

Jayne Roth reported the AKTION Club has been successful in raising money to pay for their field trip to the Smiles Horse Riding Stable in Delavan on August 19. The Club has been supporting Smiles this year.

Our new member Bob Morin was recognized. Bob was inducted July 30.

Ed Pulliam informed us that former Club President Tom Hornig is joining the downtown Madison Club. Tom moved to McFarland several years ago.

Program:

Rob Terry introduced Police Chief David Moore, and he spoke about the Janesville Police Dept.'s organization plan and their work. There are now 104 sworn officers and 17 non-sworn employees of the Department. The sworn officers include 2 deputy chiefs. 92% of the current budget for the Police Dept. is for wages and personnel related costs.

Heroin users now account for the largest number of arrests in regard to drug enforcement laws and ordinances. The total number of 911 calls for Janesville police officers was 69,470 in 2008; that's an average of 190 calls per day, amazing!

Police officers are assigned to 1 of 7 neighborhoods in the City, and Chief Moore said this has improved relationships and the exchange of information about illegal activity and crimes, because the officers have gained the trust of citizens in their neighborhood. He also feels that police officers in our schools has been worthwhile. Most students respect the officer in their school, and this results in better understanding of the police's role.
