Announcements: **IMPORTANT MEETING SEPTEMBER 3.**

Please plan to attend this meeting if at all possible, we will be voting on some extremely important issues regarding charting the future of the club:

The vote will be regarding 2 by-law changes with one other change. The first change will be how we charge for meals, from now on we will only charge for meals consumed rather than for every week whether you are there or not. This will necessitate a new club dues to cover our administrative costs regarding student and guest meals, and other administrative costs. The advantage to this structure is that many businesses will cover dues for a member, but not meals.

The first by-law change will be regarding meetings. The board is proposing we move to two scheduled meetings per month, with the off weeks to be used for outreach such as K-Clubs or Builders Clubs meetings, or service time such as park clean up. The second by-law change will allow the board to appoint the position of secretary rather than by election. This will put us in compliance with Kiwanis International by-laws.
