Our Pres.-Elect, Jayme Roth, presided at today's meeting, and she announced the major changes in our Club's meeting dates, meeting place, and information on how we will become more responsive to meeting the needs in our community. Our Board of Directors approved these changes at a Sept. 10, 2009 meeting:

Meeting place – effective October 1, The Armory, 10 S. High St., at 12:00 Noon.

Meeting dates – 1st and 3rd Thursdays of each month. Programs will be presented on the 1st Thursdays and Club business will be handled on the 3rd Thursdays.

Meal charges - \$10.50 per meal, buffet, and members will only be charged if they consume a meal. We are discontinuing the practice of billing for meals in advance.

Dues – our local Club dues amount will increase. Dues to Kiwanis Inter'l and our District will not change. Sec'y Ed Pulliam will send a letter explaining all of this. We will vote on the amount on Oct. 1, 2009.

Our Treasurer estimates the cost of being a member of the Kiwanis Club of Janesville will decrease about \$40 per year for each person in 2009-10, so that's good news!. The principal reason for these changes is to make our Club members more service-minded. This is the basic reason most of us joined Kiwanis. The Board believes this new plan will work, because our committees will have two other days (2nd & 4th weeks) of a month to meet, plan their work, and brain-storm new projects, at whatever time and location they chose.
