### **Program:**

Kelsey Burton from the American Red Cross was with us today. She informed us that it is important that we all be prepared for possible disasters and other emergencies. Natural or human-caused disasters can strike suddenly, at anytime and anywhere. There are three actions everyone can take that can help make a difference....

1. Get a Kit
2. Make a plan
3. Be informed

Getting a kit involves having at least three days of supplies in an easy-to-carry evacuation kit, with additional supplies on hand. Remember to check your kit and replace the stock every six months. The kit should include items such as water, food, 1<sup>st</sup> aid kit, medications, radio, tools, clothing, personal items, sanitary supplies, money, contact information and maps.

Making a plan will help you have the best possible response to disaster. Discuss with your family the disasters that can happen where you live. Establish responsibilities for each member of your household and plan to work together as a team. Choose two places to meet after a disaster, right outside your home in the case of sudden emergencies such as fire or outside your neighborhood in case you cannot return to your home.

Be informed by contacting your local Red Cross chapter to ask about 1<sup>st</sup> aid, CPR and disaster training. Learning simple 1<sup>st</sup> aid techniques can give you the skills and confidence to help when someone in your home, your neighborhood or workplace is injured.
