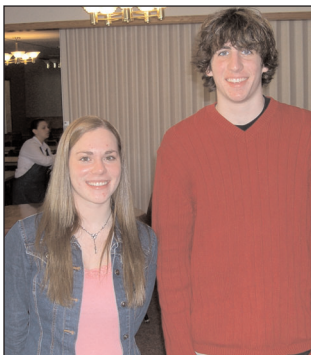
## O'Leary elected as President-Elect!

I'm sure I've missed some other great things we do. Feel free to let me know.

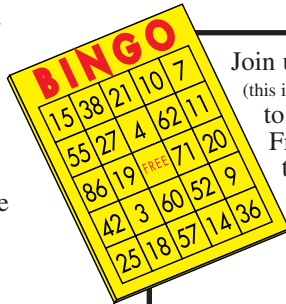
### HAPPY DOLLARS:
